# The Project



Since 2003, Jyoti Kalash has been a voice for the voiceless—defending the weak and upholding the rights of the poor. We have been dedicated to uplifting marginalized women and children in Mumbai and Goa.

Our mission is to restore and transform lives through education and therapy, giving children the tools to heal and thrive. We walk with women breaking free from abuse, helping them rediscover identity and live in freedom.

## *The key elements include:*



- Health & Hygiene: Life skills and essential Care Packages.
- Play & Art Therapy: Creative outlets for healing.
- Trauma Recovery Workshops: Helping children process and overcome trauma.
- Capacity Building: Training caretakers and staff for sustained support.
- Steps to freedom: Rehabilitating sex trafficking survivors in the RLA through outreach training and employment.
- From learning to livelihood: Educational Scholarships, Tailoring and Computer Hardware Training for sustained support.

Over the past year, sessions focused on building discipline, respect, and collaboration among the girls. Through games, creative activities, and character-building exercises, participants explored personal strengths, valued their uniqueness, and learned to honor diverse perspectives. Care for materials and peer creations reinforced self-respect and group harmony.

While engagement was strong, deeper emotional reflection was harder for some, with occasional performance anxiety. Guided support encouraged cooperation and peer encouragement. The last quarter showed progress in attention, participation, and cooperation, though impulsivity and distractibility remains a challenge. The CDFIN's trauma-competent caregiver training that was organized, helped strengthen staff capacity.

Over the past year, sessions for the girls focused on emotional regulation, safety awareness, hygiene ownership, and gradually transitioned toward rehabilitation. Through life skills activities and guided discussions, facilitators helped participants explore emotions, manage anger constructively, and build self-awareness in a supportive environment.

The group showed steady progress increased cooperation, respect for peers and materials, improved participation despite a floating population, and growing confidence with therapeutic tools. With consistent engagement and demonstrated understanding, the structured Health and Hygiene goal was successfully concluded, paving the way for rehabilitation-focused work.

Update



Women are equipped with practical skills in tailoring and advanced bag design, supported by stipends that foster economic independence. Alongside vocational training, trauma-focused counselling sessions help women heal emotional wounds, build resilience, and rediscover hope. Twenty-two structured life skill modules covering communication, self-esteem, decision-making, budgeting, and goal setting further strengthen everyday resilience.

Update

To ensure well-being, every trainee receives a nutritious meal daily. Children benefit from a safe, nurturing environment while their mothers train, with life skills sessions and art therapy helping them grow in confidence, character, and hope.

Healthcare remains a vital part of our mission. Our team accompanies women to hospitals for regular check-ups and collaborates with partner organizations to provide accessible, quality medical care. Staff capacity was strengthened through trauma-competent caregiver training conducted by CDFIN.

The Annual Event celebrated in Dec 2025, was organised at all the RLA Outreach Centers and was attended by large number of women.

In the last quarter, sessions on HIV/AIDS awareness, birth control, and personal identity were conducted across centres, reinforcing knowledge and self-worth.

The Ashadai Kendra Project in Goa is actively uplifting low-income communities, especially women and children, through education, vocational training (tailoring), and community-building.

It supports girl child education with scholarships and tuition classes, while nearly 100 students across India are currently receiving scholarships for primary, secondary, higher secondary, and vocational studies.

Update



Daily sewing classes are training 24 women in tailoring skills, enabling them to move toward financial independence. Community spirit continues to grow through events such as Women's Day, group birthday celebrations for children, that bring participants together in joy and bonding.

In Andhra Pradesh, a sewing project is empowering Koya Tribal women with vocational skills, fostering financial independence and strengthening their role in the community.

## Update



### Bright Light Computer Center

The Bright Light Computer Training Center was launched in August 2025. The center repurposed e-waste and broken computers into a functional training space, offering hands-on lessons in repair and basic digital skills to under served community.

Students quickly completed the Basic Repair module, with some advancing to higher levels. By 2026, the program expanded to include introductory computer use classes and began planning partnerships with schools to deliver workshops on responsible technology use, AI awareness, and troubleshooting.

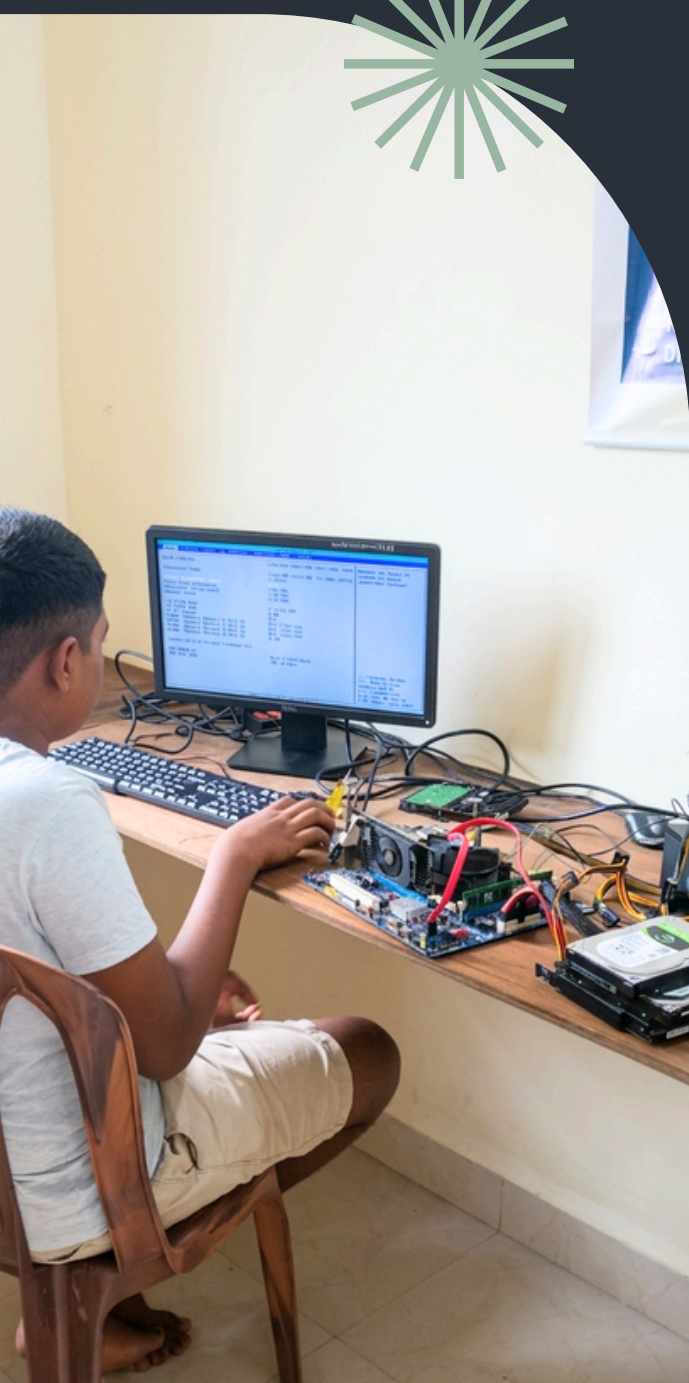


## Computer Training Center
